

Requirements: Read 2 novels and complete all assignments. Be prepared to turn in assignments on first day of school and be ready to test over the novels the first Friday of school. Both assignments and final test are major grades.

I. NOVELS

Lord of the Flies by William Golding

Ender’s Game by Orson Scott Card.

These novels may be purchased online or at any bookstore, checked out from local library, OR read online-your choice.

II. ASSIGNMENTS

Complete the following for each novel:

A. Write down 10 key passages from each novel.

Selections should cover the entire span of the book (beginning, middle, and end).

Your choices should be ones that help develop the characters or theme of the novel, or reveal the culture and society of the novel’s setting.

B. For each of the 10 passages, explain in a detailed paragraph why/how that passage is significant.

At the end of each paragraph write the chapter number and page number your passage was found in/on. Each paragraph should be comprised of at least 5-7 sentences, and contain your own original thoughts and ideas. Any plagiarism will result in a zero on this major grade with there will be NO chance of making it up.

*EXAMPLE:*

To Kill a Mockingbird

Passage	Significance
<p><i>“A mob’s always made up of people, no matter what. Mr. Cunningham was part of a mob last night, but he was still a man. Every mob in every little Southern town is always made up of people you know- Doesn’t say much for them, does it?”</i>  <i>Chapter 5, page 44</i></p>	<p>This quote refers to the mob that almost attacked Atticus in order to enter the jail to lynch Tom Robinson. The quote sums up a truth that Scout learns over the course of the book: that individuals you may know and even respect can band together to do terrible things. Although mobs may seem anonymous, they are made up of individual people who live otherwise normal lives. CULTURE, SOCIETY</p>
